
APSC SA STICS MATCH

Friday & Saturday, 11 & 12 August 2018

Hi everyone

As you may be aware but, if you weren't you are now, IPSC(SA) is running the next STICS match as a 2-day match, for which we have international Level III sanctioning, at Adelaide Pistol & Shooting Club on Saturday & Sunday, 11 & 12 August.

There are 12 Stages with a minimum of 210 rounds. ROs will be assigned full-time to each Stage so you will be able to more enjoy the shooting.

Because it is a Level III and 2 day match, the organisation behind the scenes is a lot more complex and, to this end, we will not be able to accept entries on-the-day like we do for a normal 1-day Level II SA STICS match.

There is an online entry system like we used for the SA State Titles earlier this year and this can be found at <https://www.ipsc.org.au/2018-apsc-sa-stics-match-entry-form/>. You can pay by credit card online at the time or by EFT after entering. The fee is \$60 when done by either of those 2 options. Online entries close at 6:00pm on Thursday 9 August to enable advance squadding and scheduling to be done.

We will also accept entries on Friday 10 August during Registration period 1:00pm - 5:00pm but only in person at the APSC range but then the cost is then \$70 and in cash only.

Remember – no Entries will be accepted on the Saturday first day of the match.

Registration will be open from 1:00pm to 5:00pm on Friday 10 August at the APSC range. You may attend to register (and enter if you haven't done so online) during this period. Registration will also be open on the Saturday start day from 7:00am to 8:00am but we request that you let us know in advance by email to ipsc@projectability.com.au if you have to register on the Saturday. Note that Saturday registration will only be available if you have previously entered the match.

The full *Conditions of Entry* are present on the website where you go to enter the match.

Sorry if this all seems a little imposing or restrictive when compared to a normal 1-day STICS match and we hope it does not put you off coming to this first attempt at a Level III outside of the State Titles. Unfortunately, it is necessary in order to ensure the match team can present a well-organised match for the enjoyment of all.
