IPSC 2020 World Handgun Championships

Due to the continuing COVID-19 situation, the IPSC Executive Council has decided to reschedule the IPSC Calendar of events for 2020 through to 2022. The decision was taken in conjunction with the host regions of the following matches;

- *Handgun World Shoot XIX and General Assembly 2020, Pattaya, Thailand*
Postponed to November/December 2021
- *Shotgun World Shoot IV 2021, Pattaya, Thailand*
Postponed to November/December 2022
- *Action Air World Shoot II 2021*
Postponed to 2022. Dates to be advised.
- *PCC World Shoot 2021*
Postponed to 2022. Dates to be advised.

Further information including an official match schedule for WS XIX is to be available in the coming days and weeks.

IPSC Australia understands that this was a difficult decision for the match organisers, and we wish them the best in their planning and rescheduling process. We now have more time to prepare for the World Shoot in Thailand and look forward to a fantastic event and to the great hospitality that we all know Thailand will have for everyone.
